
## Region “C” Citation



On June 26<sup>th</sup>, 2024 a subject armed with a gun robbed Truist Bank of Kings Mountain. The Criminal Investigations Unit immediately responded and began processing the scene while also conducting follow-up investigations in attempting to identify the suspect and his vehicle. Through video surveillance and Automatic License Plate Reader (ALPR), the vehicle was identified and led to a suspect that matched the bank’s surveillance as well. Through quick and proactive investigative techniques, on that same date later in the evening, the suspect was tracked through his cell phone to a location in Mount Holly North Carolina where he was apprehended without incident.

campaign August 26th through September 8th.


