In May 2024, KMPD began the process of applying for this prestigious grant, headed up by Landon Childers, focusing on the critical area of Building Legitimacy and Trust with the citizens of Kings Mountain. By engaging community stakeholders—including residents, local businesses, and faith-based organizations—KMPD aims to strengthen collaborative responses to crime and enhancing overall community well-being. On September 17th we were notified that the grant application was successful. The grant will provide \$250,000 in support of hiring two new police officers and funding same for 36 months. This grant is a testament to our ongoing commitment to building strong relationships with our community. By working together with our residents, we can create a safer and more vibrant Kings Mountain.
